

# The Medway Squib Fleet

The River Medway Squib Fleet is based at Medway Yacht Club adjacent to Upnor Castle, within easy reach of London and the M25.

The fleet is active, growing year on year, supportive and inclusive.

## RACING

Class racing every Saturday in the season (April to November) attracting 6-10 boats each week. A wide range in ability ensures good sailing for all standards of crew and the opportunity to improve.

The fleet uses the static River Navigation marks with races lasting 2-3 hours and covering from 6-11 miles depending of wind, tide and the choice from a list of C 90 pre-set courses.

## CRUISING

Several cruises are organised each season. Typical events include: Raft-up Lunch with other classes, a decent pub lunch at Queenborough etc.

## TRAINING

Medway Yacht Club has a full time training officer and an active training programme for Squibs and other classes. The Squib is seen as an entry Racing Keel Boat with high demand throughout the season. The Training centre also offers wider RYA courses to cover VHF, First Aid and Power Boat Qualifications.

## General Facilities

The Yacht club offers excellent Restaurant and Social events throughout the year enabling Squib Crews to enjoy a good lunch before the race as well as a jovial debrief afterwards. As one might expect from a long established club, there is an active and well organised social calendar.
